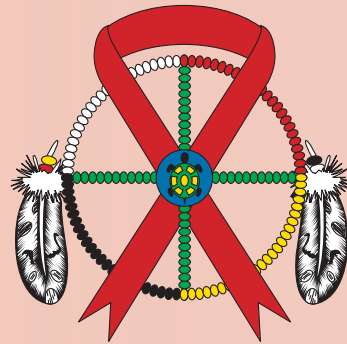


OFFICE MANDATE

We are guided on this Mission by the people we help.

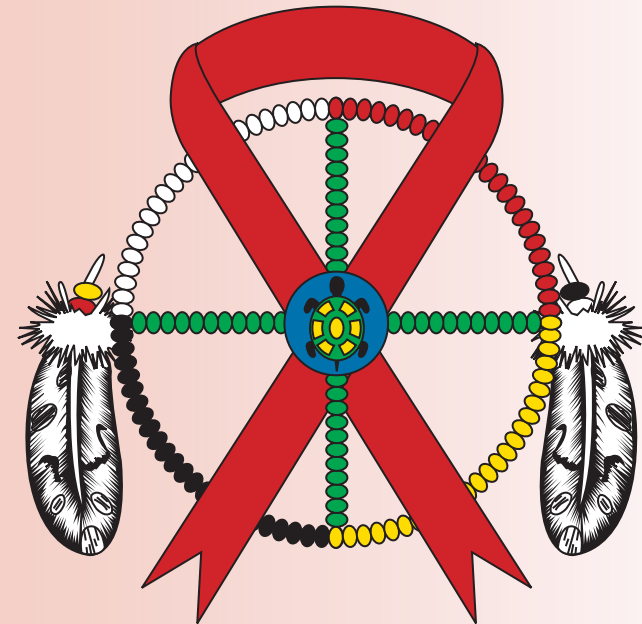

Healing Our Nations was formed in 1991 by two Mi'kmaq people who were concerned about HIV/AIDS and the effects it could have on our communities.

Together, they asked others to share in teaching our people about the virus.

Today, First Nation Mi'kmaq and Maliseet communities across Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland have joined in the effort to help promote awareness and healthy living.
